



## 1. Foreword

- 1.1 These rules are drawn up by the Scout Association of Malta - Campsite Team, and apply to all persons using Ghajn Tuffieha Camp Site (herein referred to as “the Site”).
- 1.2 The Site is run by volunteers and used mainly by the Scout and Guide Movements. The campsite and facilities may also be used by other youth organizations, institutions, and the general public, subject to availability and approval.
- 1.3 Use of the Site is at campers’ own risk and the Association is not liable for any loss of property, regardless of how this loss may occur.
- 1.4 Earliest Arrival Time: 08:00 Hrs      Latest Departure Time: 16.00 Hrs
- 1.6 The Campsite Management allocate plots at their discretion and their decision is final.

## 2. General Rules of the Site

- 2.1 The security gates at the entrance to the site must be **closed** at all times.
- 2.2 Respect for the property must be observed.
- 2.3 Loud music is not allowed. The organisation of unauthorised gatherings/parties is strictly prohibited.
- 2.4 Campers are responsible for the well-being and safety of the children in their care.
- 2.5 Dogs must be kept under control and on a leash. Dogs’ mess must be cleared up.
- 2.6 A general lights-out and quiet time starts at **23.00** hours and lasts till **07.00** hours the following morning. Any person/s not abiding by this rule may be asked to leave the campsite immediately.
- 2.7 Open fires lit on the campsite are not permissible. A fire drum may be used (supplied by Campers) however this must be placed a safe distance from trees, shrubs and rubble walls and should not be higher than 30cm. Fires must be supervised at all times and must be completely extinguished before lights out.
- 2.8 The Campsite Personnel must be notified in advance of any visitors.
- 2.9 **Rubble walls must not be dismantled.**

## 3. Incident/Accident Procedure

- 3.1 Any incidents or accidents are to be reported to the Campsite Personnel, or if not present, please call **9983 9983**

## 4. Campsite Personnel (when in attendance)

- 4.1 Inform the Campsite Personnel upon arrival, and before departure.

## 5. Vehicles

- 5.1 The speed limit on the site is **10km** per hour.
- 5.2 The car park located adjacent to the Main Gate and behind the container is to be used by all campers and visitors.
- 5.3 **Motor vehicles should be moved to the car park after unloading.**
- 5.4 No unnecessary movement of vehicles should occur on the site between 23.00 and 06.00 hours.

## 6. Environmental Issues

- 6.1 Great care should be taken of trees and shrubs – charges will be imposed on individuals causing damage.
- 6.2 Campers must place all litter/garbage in the skips/recycling bins provided at the entrance to the campsite.
- 6.3 Any left-over wood brought to the campsite should be removed from the plots by the campers.

## 7. General Toilet/Shower Block Rules

- 7.1 No smoking is allowed in any part of the block.
- 7.2 Do not wash kitchen utensils in the shower block sinks - washing of utensils must take place on the camping plot allocated to you.
- 7.3 Any damage or breakage to any part of the building or contents may be chargeable.
- 7.4 Users of the block are asked to conserve energy and **switch lights off** please after use.
- 7.5 Missing keys must be reported immediately. A replacement cost for the lock will be charged.
- 7.6 No naked flames or stoves are to be used within the Ablution Block.
- 7.7 Dogs are not allowed inside the toilet/shower block
- 7.8 The campsite does not provide toilet paper.
