

1. General Rules of the Site

- 1.1 The security gates at the entrance to the site must be **closed** at all times.
- 1.2 Motor vehicles are not allowed on the plots and are only allowed inside the campsite for un/loading. All motor vehicles should be moved and parked in the car park as soon as equipment is unloaded.
- 1.3 **A fine of €10 per car per day will be charged for any cars parked on the plots.**
- 1.4 The speed limit on the site is **5km** per hour.

2. General Toilet/Shower Block Rules

- 2.1 Smoking is NOT allowed in any part of the block.
- 2.2 Kitchen utensils must not be washed in the sinks of the shower block.
- 2.3 Any damage or breakage to any part of the building or contents must be reported to the campsite staff and may be chargeable.
- 2.4 Missing keys must be reported immediately. A replacement cost for the lock will be charged.
- 2.5 No naked flames or stoves are to be used within the Ablution Block.
- 2.6 Dogs are not allowed inside the toilet/shower block
- 2.7 The campsite does not provide toilet paper.

3. Respect for property & others

- 3.1 Campers must respect the property and other campers at all times.
- 3.2 Care should be taken not to damage trees and shrubs – charges will be imposed on individuals causing damage.
- 3.3 Rubble walls must not be dismantled. Standing on or climbing over the rubble walls is not permitted.
- 3.4 Campers must place all litter/garbage in the skips/recycling bins provided at the entrance to the campsite.
- 3.5 Any left-over wood brought to the campsite should be removed from the plots by the campers.
- 3.6 Loud music is not allowed. The organisation of unauthorised gatherings/parties is strictly prohibited.
- 3.7 Open fires lit on the campsite are not permissible. A fire drum may be used (supplied by Campers) however this must be placed a safe distance from trees, shrubs and rubble walls and should not be higher than 30cm. Fires must be supervised at all times and must be completely extinguished before lights out. It is the responsibility of the camper to ensure that a fire extinguisher is at hand.
- 3.8 A general lights-out and quiet time starts at **23.00** hours and lasts till **07.00** hours the following morning. Any person/s not abiding by this rule may be asked to leave the campsite immediately.

4. Children & Pets

- 4.1 Children should be supervised at all times. Campers are responsible for the well-being and safety of the children in their care.
- 4.2 Dogs must be kept under control and on a leash. Dogs' mess must be cleared up.
- 4.3 The Campsite Staff must be notified in advance of any visitors.

5. Incident/Accident Procedure

- 5.1 Any incidents or accidents are to be reported to the Campsite Staff at reception or by calling **9983 9983**
